A comment about Mayana's film:

"Throughout history, people have sought meaning in other peoples' stories. Millennia-ago, for example, people became inspired by the stories of wandering animal herders and Egyptian expatriates (or, as we know them, the Children of Israel.) Only parts of those stories will ever be known, but their power derives in part from that mysterious nature. Mayana Bonapart's film is intensely personal, and distinctively from a time and place in California. Her Uncle Andy passed away at an early age, while traveling; and the recorded journal he left behind has become a kind of call for her to wander the world herself. To see how powerfully she has become inspired -by the stories Andy chose to record, and by the mystery of what he left out- is to think about the nature of inspiration; and to reflect on how real people sometimes transcend their origins by telling of their
